TOEFL - INFORMATIONS

(TEST OF ENGLISH AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE)

To apply for a course at Quadriga University Berlin, you must demonstrate your English language skills by successfully completing the internet-based TOEFL test.

The TOEFL is an internationally accepted standard test, which assesses non-native speakers' knowledge of the English language. This online test is carried out all over the world by the Educational Testing Service (ETS). The test is based on the kind of language used in an academic context, and is a certification recognised worldwide at more than 4,500 universities and colleges.

The test has four sections, testing both oral and written comprehension as well as independent writing and speaking ability.

To be admitted to Quadriga University Berlin, a minimum score of 80 points is required. Please note that the test becomes invalid after two years, as linguistic skills can change dramatically in a very short space of time.

To find out about test dates and test centres, please consult the ETS homepage www.ets.org. The TOEFL in Germany is carried out in more than 30 cities. More information about the test centre closest to your home is forwarded to you after you have registered online on the ETS website www.de.toefl.eu or by calling the European head office's hotline: +31 320 239 540.

At present, the TOEFL costs \$ 245 (status quo November 2017). Information on registering can be found at www.ets.org/toefl. The application for the test is done online.

A certain amount of preparation for the test is recommended. The Educational Testing Service offers online-training courses and learning tools. Many test centres also offer courses for the test.
